Diverse talent highlights finals

Regional final weekend in Northern California features some intriguing matchups, including a Miramonte-Salesian rematch and Brookside Christian facing off with Pinewood in Division V. Before heading out to the games, get caught up on the top prospects.

Open Division: Salesian vs. Miramonte

Mariya Moore 6-foot-0 W Salesian (2014): The 5-star and McDonald's All-American is on the short list for the NorCal Player of the Year. She is a physical driver who makes a living at the free throw line and can fill up the stat sheet. She is signed to Louisville.

Zoe Correal 6-foot-4 Post Salesian (2014): A rim protector for the Pride, Correal is a 3-star prospect and is ranked No. 18 in the NCP Top 40. With legit size and continuing to improve, she is signed to Colorado.

Sabrina Ionescu 5-foot-11 G Miramonte (2016): The best sophomore in NorCal and one of the best in the country, Ionescu has helped spearhead road wins over St. Mary's-Stockton and Carondelet. She is a playmaker with the ball in her hands and active on defense.

Breanna Alford 5-foot-11 PF Miramonte (2014): Playing in the Matadors' up-tempo system, Alford is a tough rebounder who can finish inside in transition. Ranked No. 27 in the NCP Top 40, she is signed to Loyola Marymount.

Division I: Berkeley vs. Pleasant Grove

Desire Finnie 5-foot-10 F Berkeley (2014): With her athleticism and ever improving skill set, Finnie has had a good year for the Yellowjackets. She has a very good motor, is a good rebounder and a nice mid-range game. The 3-star recruit is signed to Pacific.

Jaiamoni Welch-Coleman 5-foot-2 PG Berkeley (2015): Welch-Coleman has been instrumental in Berkeley's NorCal wins over McClatchy and Deer Valley. Ranked No. 22 in the 2015 rankings, Welch-Coleman has good quickness and plays hard in running the point for Berkeley.

Aaliyah Pena 6-foot-2 Post Pleasant Grove (2014): Pena is headed to UC Riverside and will try to help the Eagles win their first NorCal title. She runs the floor well and is improving as a scorer around the basket. She is ranked as a 3-star prospect and No. 26 in the NCP rankings.

Division II: Mitty vs. McNair

Kelli Hayes 6-foot-1 W Mitty (2014): Hayes was named co-Player of the Year in the West Catholic Athletic League. She is a very versatile player who can dominate the action without scoring. Ranked No. 4 in a loaded 2014 class, Hayes is signed to UCLA as part of the top recruiting class in the country.

Katliyn Griffin 5-foot-6 PG Mitty (2016): Griffin has worked back from a knee injury to give Mitty another solid guard. Look for her and Jahnay Anderson to be the next top players for the Monarchs after combining to average 11 points per game this year.

Mandy Coleman 6-foot-3 F McNair (2014): Coleman can play at multiple spots on the floor and had BCS schools from out of the area coming after her this summer. The 4-star prospect ended up signing with Oklahoma State.

Tiara Tucker 5-foot-6 PG McNair (2014): Tucker is a talented lead guard who can get to the basket, but also challenge you with her range. She is active on defense and is the third ranked point guard in the region. She committed to San Francisco early before signing with the Dons in November.

Division III: Enterprise vs. Modesto Christian

Kamira Sanders 5-foot-6 G Enterprise (2016): Not much is known on Sanders, but there is plenty of early buzz for one of the top prospects to come out of the Northern Section in recent years. As a sophomore, she is averaging 18 points, three rebounds, four assists and three steals.

Lexi Tubbs 5-foot-11 SF Modesto Christian (2014): Tubbs is a shooter with length who will be a good

Division IV: Arcata vs. Justin-Siena

Lauren McCoy Post Arcata (2014): McCoy was named the Eureka Times Standard MVP as a junior and has followed it up with 13 points, 11 rebounds and two blocks per game this year.

[Haley Cremen](#) 5-foot-11 Post Justin-Siena (2014): The senior post has been named Napa County Player of the Year as a sophomore and junior and looks to be on her way to a third straight honor. She is signed to Chico State and scored 27 points in the upset win over Scotts Valley.

Division V: Brookside Christian vs. Pinewood

[Ra'Kyra Gabriel](#) 6-foot-1 Post Brookside Christian (2015): Gabriel is one of a number of prospects who could break out to form a second tier in the 2015 class. She competes inside and can play a little on the perimeter. A big game from Gabriel could mean a NorCal title for the Knights.

Chloe Eackles 5-foot-10 F Pinewood (2016): The sophomore has had a solid year for the Panthers at six points and seven rebounds per game. She provides the interior size for Pinewood along with senior Leeana Bade.
