Bay Area players - all California boys - snubbed again in McDonald's game

For the second straight year there will be no Bay Area players in either McDonald's All-America basketball game.

And, even more surprising, there won't be a single male player from California.

Is that possible?

There teams were announced earlier this afternoon. See the squads: [BOYS](#) and [GIRLS](#).

There were two major hopefuls from the Bay Area in Oakland senior Jabari Brown, on virtually everyone's Top 20 recruit list.

The other was Berkeley senior Brittany Boyd, who basically toys with local competition. She could score more than 20 points per game but is extremely unselfish and does everything else for the top-ranked Yellowjackets.

A total of six Golden State girls were selected, all from Southern California including the leading national Player of the Year candidate Kaleena Mosqueda-Lewis, of Mater Dei-Santa Ana. She's headed to Connecticut.

Brown has signed to Oregon and Boyd to to Cal.

There are three other Bay Area-bound girls on the 24-person roster: Washington-Los Angeles 6-3 forward Reshanda Gray to Cal, and Stanford-signees Bonnie Samuelson, a 6-3 forward from Edison-Huntington Beach, and Amber Orrange (no miss-print there folks), a 5-8 guard from Westbury Christian (Houston, Texas).
